WRC 2012 Race Report:

697 participants (333 teams) from 29 countries took part in the event. Final results are enclosed (attachment No. 1).

3 written protests were heard by the Jury (see attachment 2 – 4) and all of them were rejected. Other verbal complaints concerned check point No. 80. Immediately after the start a long queue was formed there and some teams weren't able to keep the rule of punching within 1 minute. Organizers admitted that one recording device per checkpoint close to start was not sufficient and asked the Jury to approve granting 80 points each to 3 teams that omitted the 1 minute rule at the CP 80. Jury has approved the suggestion via e-mail.


Medical staff at the Event Centre gave medical treatment to a few slightly injured persons and a few people who were tired out. No rescue drive to the race area or a call for an ambulance was needed.

Minirogaining Race Report:

17 participants from 5 countries took part in the minirogaine event and handed in a punching card at finish. All check points were marked by a small flag (manual punching) and were placed sufficiently far from the WRC 2012 check points. The race attracted several local people; some other persons registered but did not start, just watched the finish of the WRC 2012. Final results of the minirogaining are enclosed (attachment No. 5).
